



Road Maintenance Practices under the *Forest and Range Practices Act*

You have knowledge and experience about road maintenance obligations under the *Forest Practices Code of BC Act* and the *Forest Road Regulation*. Does anything change under the *Forest and Range Practices Act*? When does an industrial forest road become a wilderness road? Can road status change back from wilderness road to industrial road? What obligations exist for maintenance to the wilderness road standard?

This training module was developed by the Ministry of Forests, Resource Tenures and Engineering Branch, to focus attention on the requirements, obligations and expectations for road maintenance in the results based world of the *Forest and Range Practices Act*. Although industrial roads will be covered, emphasis will be placed on the "wilderness road" classification when exploring such questions as "why should I even worry about wilderness roads if we're not hauling on them?" or "does it make business sense to maintain the structural integrity of the wilderness road?"

Key elements to be covered in the training to explain the need and importance of maintaining forest roads are:

- existing legislation (overview);
- road maintenance standards, FRPA obligations;
- maintenance implications for industrial roads and wilderness roads (environmental, structural);
- the concepts of professional reliance and the process of due diligence as they relate to road maintenance obligations;
- road maintenance plans (ideas, forms); and
- sources of best management practices.

AUDIENCE

This training is designed for those who are involved in forest road management, including road planning, road use permits, road inspections, maintenance operations, deactivation and/or supervision activities. The workshop will be of interest to industry, consultants, licence holders, contractors and government staff, including BCTS and Compliance & Enforcement. It is designed to encourage participant dialogue with the view of adding value for all.
