This training will cover the changes to legal requirements under the *Forest and Range Practices Act* (FRPA). These changes arise from:

- Bill 33 amendments to FRPA, passed in May 2004;
- *FRPA* regulations in force as of December 2004 and February 2005;
- Other new *FRPA* components brought in since January 2004.

A team of presenters will deliver the session, and policy specialists will be available to respond to questions.

**Who Should Attend?**

- Government, industry and consulting staff involved in forest practices policy, planning, and activities;
- People responsible for developing, reviewing, approving or implementing FSP's. This includes major and minor licence holders, and resource professional and technical staff;
- Timber Sales staff, community forest agreement holders and First Nations who hold or potentially will hold tenure agreements.
