

TENURE NAMING CONVENTIONS

These names are legal and appear on the Exhibit 'A' document. Any names formed must be used throughout on all subsequent documents and reports and must remain consistent throughout its lifetime.

Road Permit – Must begin with the letter R and is followed by 5 numbers. All new RP application File IDs are auto-generated in the system.

Road Permit Section ID - The “Road Section Identifier” is the primary and mandatory naming mechanism. Can be up to a maximum of 30 alpha-numeric characters. When creating a road section identifier refrain from using any “XML Reserved Characters” for these contain special meaning within the XML syntax. Use of these characters in attribute descriptions will cause the XML/GML submission to fail (see ESF Submission Guide).

Recommendation: Try to avoid using “_” (underscores) and “ ” (spaces) as they cause confusion or legibility issues on maps.

XML Reserved Characters:

Road Name field is optional:

Do not re-enter Road Permit Section ID. **No symbols allowed.** [On page 15 of the Industry & BCTS Guide to the Submission of Road Tenure via the Electronic Submission Framework \(ESF\) Version 2.5 June 4, 2007, it states, Road Name as Optional and if you read the Details it states the road name is NOT the road section/branch Identifier found in FTA. Of course if you have an alternate or local road name then by all means use it.](#)

Cutting Permit – Must be a maximum of 3 alpha - numeric characters. **No symbols or spaces allowed. No 'I' or 'O' allowed.**

Cut Block ID - Must be a maximum of 10 alpha - numeric characters and be unique for a given TIMBER MARK/FOREST FILE ID. **No symbols or spaces allowed. No 'I' or 'O' allowed.**

Other Tenure Types -

A04, A44 and A06: The CP ID must be 2 alpha characters only. **No "I" or "O" allowed.**

A20-A24, A28, A29 and A31: Can only have 1 letter. **No symbols or spaces allowed. No 'I' or 'O' allowed.**
