Your Woodlot Licence Plan (WLP) submission of January 16, 2006 and as amended February 28, 2006 for Woodlot Licence W1942 for the years 2006 to 2016 has now been fully reviewed.

The Ministry of Forests and Range remains committed to a meaningful consultation process with First Nations who may assert traditional aboriginal interests in an area covered by this WLP. The particulars of this WLP have been communicated to the appropriate First Nations and their input has been encouraged. To date, I have not been advised of any site-specific aboriginal interests that may be infringed upon by the proposed development described in this WLP.

The term of this plan is March 19, 2006 to March 18, 2016. Further development taking place on Woodlot Licence W1942 must be done in accordance with the approved WLP. This letter forms an integral part of the WLP for Woodlot Licence W1942 and should be attached thereto.
