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**PART A GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Each area will be partial cut retaining a free-growing stand, or will be stocked in accordance with Section 46 of the Forest Planning and Practices Regulation.
- All clearcut areas will be < 1 ha (including consideration of adjacent areas).
- Salvage will result in clearcut(s) > 1 ha or result in residual stocking of selectively harvested stands being lower than the acceptable standards, therefore incurring a silviculture liability to the Crown. Site Plans have been prepared and are attached as part of this application.

- Request authority to fell and utilize danger or hazard trees within 1 ½ tree lengths around the permit area and/or RoW and/or skid trail.
- This FLTC is for salvaging beetle, (Douglas Fir, Mountain Pine and Spruce Bark Beetle), infested timber only (all phases of attack). This FLTC may include healthy timber that is interspersed with the dead and beetle attacked timber and timber necessary to be removed for safety and access up to a maximum of **20%** of the approved harvest volume.
