DISTRICT MANAGER CONDITIONS:

1. The volume for each exempted area does not exceed 500 cubic meters.
2. Clearcut areas to be exempted, together with any adjoining clearcut area that is subject to an exemption, must not exceed 1.0 hectare in total.
3. For non clearcut areas this exemption must not be adjacent to an area that has been previously exempted.
4. Cutblocks greater than 1.0 hectare will be left fully stocked at completion of harvesting. Blocks greater than 1 hectare that are not left free growing require Site Plans and are not eligible for exemption.
5. Exempted areas are subject to all other Practice Requirements as outlined in the licensee's Forest Stewardship Plan or, for areas not subject to a Forest Stewardship Plan, subject to the Practice Requirements listed in Part 4, Division 1 of the *Forest and Planning Practices Regulation*.
6. On or before April 30 of each year, the applicant will submit to the district manager a report of the area(s) harvested in the preceding 12 months, containing all of the following information:
 - a map showing the area, location and shape of openings that have been harvested, the location of roads and access trails, mappable reserves
 - a table listing cutting permit, block, location (mapsheet number and geographic name), timber type, age, area harvested, total volume harvested, host species volume, infested/damaged volume, green to red attack ratio
7. This exemption expires one year after the date that it is approved.

This approval constitutes an amendment to Cutting Permit _____ of your Licence _____ to include the areas approved in this exemption. This approval forms an integral part of licence/permit document and should be attached to it.
