FREE USE PERMIT	<p>A FUP can be entered into only with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) an occupier of land who requires Crown timber for developing the land of agricultural purposes (b) a person who requires a Christmas tree for their personal use and not for sale to others, (these FUPs are available on our website or at our front desk) (c) a person who requires firewood for their personal domestic purposes and not for sale to others (these FUPs are available at our front desk and can be faxed) (d) a school board that requires firewood for school purposes, (e) a person who requires Crown timber for the purpose of scientific investigation, (f) an owner of a Crown grant of a mineral claim, authorizing the use of Crown timber on land described in the grant in a mining operation conducted on that land (g) a holder of a coal licence issued under the <i>Coal Act</i>, or a holder of a mineral title under the <i>Mineral Tenure Act</i> not in production authorizing the holder to cut timber (h) a person who requires Crown timber for a traditional and cultural activity.
CASH SALE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) must not exceed 50 m3 per sale and for any one person/year (b) can be for green wood (c) can be for resale – commercial Christmas trees, post & rails (d) stumpage is calculated, and must be paid, before sale is issued <p>*Commercial firewood sales will be processed through the Small Scale Salvage Program.</p>
FORESTRY LICENCE TO CUT	<p>A FLTC can be issued for timber that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) is in danger, as a result of an insect infestation, fire, disease or windthrow, of being significantly reduced in value, lost or destroyed (b) is interspersed with the dead or endangered timber, or (c) must be harvested to provide access to the dead, endangered or interspersed timber <p>A FLTC is issued under the Small Scale Salvage Program. OCCUPANT LICENCE TO CUT	<p>An OLTC can be issued for harvesting timber on an area of land under a permit of occupation with Land and Water BC. Such permits may be for (but are not limited to):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • mining exploration • mining development • cat ski operations • water lines
ZONES	<p>The Okanagan Shuswap Forest District has been divided into two zones. The North zone is from Vernon north to the end of the Seymour River, South is from Vernon south to the U.S.A. border.</p>

* Applicant must have a copy of the approved document prior to commencing harvesting operations.*
