# BC Forest Service Campgrounds • A Guide to the Rules

## Drive Cautiously

- ❖ Roads are often used by visitors as paths and play areas.
- ❖ Maximum speed is 20 km/hour.
- ❖ Do not drive over the vegetation.



## Parking

- ❖ Park in designated areas.
- ❖ Keep roads clear, do not block traffic.

## Pets

- ❖ Keep your pets quiet and under control at all times.

## Campfires

- ❖ Keep your campfire small and in the fire rings provided.
- ❖ Do not light campfires during strong winds.
- ❖ Do not cut trees or remove firewood.
- ❖ Attend your campfire at all times, extinguish before leaving.



## Camping and Day Use

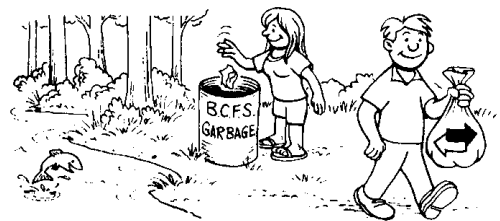
- ❖ Enjoy your stay up to a max of 14 consecutive days.
- ❖ Do not build any permanent structures.
- ❖ Return your site to its natural condition.
- ❖ Organizing a competitive event?... ask the Forest Service first.

## Safety and Hunting

- ❖ Do not discharge firearms, bows, crossbows or set traps on this site.
- ❖ Do not deposit game entrails on the sites.

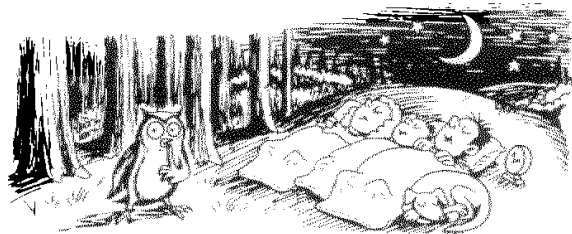
## Garbage

- ❖ You pack it in, you pack it out.
- ❖ Do not litter.
- ❖ Empty your holding tank at a sanitation facility.



## Courtesy

- ❖ Respect the peace and quiet of others.
- ❖ Keep your noise to a minimum at all times.
- ❖ Obey designated quiet time: 11 pm to 7 am.
