



Wildfire Information Document

Before April 1 of each year, a person who, under the *Forest Act*, is the holder of (a) a major forest licence, (b) a timber sale licence that is not a major licence, (c) a community forest agreement, or (d) a woodlot licence must provide an official with a 24 hour a day contact telephone number if the person proposes to carry out an industrial activity between April 1 and October 31 of that year
