As we prepare for the upcoming fire season, I would like to take the opportunity to remind you that if you intend to carry out industrial activities between April 1st and October 31st this year that the *Wildfire Regulation*, requires you to provide a **24 hour a day** contact telephone number annually. As in the past, wildfires can be reported 24 hours a day directly to the Coastal Fire Centre Fire **Emergency line at 250-951-4200** with details of the fire size, location, behavior and any resources being deployed. Alternately, you can report wildfires to the province- wide toll free reporting line at 1-800-663-5555 (*and asked to be re-routed to the Coastal Dispatch Centre in Parksville*).
