



# Ministry of Forests, Lands & Natural Resource Operations

Following is your Free Use Permit which allows you to cut dead and down wood for firewood in the **100 Mile House District**. Please fill in the blanks, sign the Permit, and carry it with you when cutting firewood. Cutting of firewood without this Permit could result in confiscation of the wood and charges under *the Forest and Range Practices Act*.

## FREE USE PERMIT FOR FIREWOOD

\_\_\_\_\_, hereby agree to the following conditions:

1. The firewood is for personal use and not for resale or use in commercial operations;
2. The maximum volume to be cut under the permit is 10 cords or 35m<sup>3</sup>;
3. Ensure that the firewood is cut from vacant Crown land;
4. All material over 15 cm (6") in diameter, that is to be removed from the site, will be cut into firewood length (less than 1m) on site;
5. Cut stumps as low as possible to the ground;
6. Clear all falling and bucking debris from roads, roadside ditches and streams, and lop all branches from felled trees and scatter them close to the ground;
7. **DO NOT** cut any trees marked by the Ministry of Environment for the preservation of wildlife;
8. **DO NOT** cut dead standing Douglas Fir trees over 65 cm (25.6 inches) in diameter at a 30 cm (1 foot) stump height. These are to be left for wildlife and birds;
9. **DO NOT** cut any live, green trees (coniferous or deciduous) or remove any Forest Company's log decks for firewood. Doing so is an infraction against the *Forest and Range Practices Act* and subject to penalty charges;
10. **DO NOT** cut firewood from woodlots or Community Forests without the owner's permission.
11. **DO NOT** Cut any tree's within a Forest Companies flagged harvest boundary. The flagging is typically orange in colour and may be labelled block boundary."
12. **DO NOT** clear or construct any access trails. All firewood must be removed by hand.
13. **DO NOT** drag logs or timber over or along any public highway, except as authorized by a permit from the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure.

I will assume responsibility for any damage, injury claim, or expense that the Crown faces as a result, directly or indirectly, of the activities carried out in connection with this permit.

This Permit is not valid until it is signed by the Applicant and is valid for **1 year** from the date of issuance.
