

## **Eligible TSAs and associated Timber Supply Review activities:**

Timber supply review (TSR) related activities for TSAs (see list of TSAs for 2004/2005 below) which are eligible for FIA funding include:

- preparation of data (must consider data content, quality and physical storage standards). The data must be electronically submitted to the government as per the defined forest area management (DFAM) TSR standards;
- completion of data packages;
- activities related to providing information for public reviews and information sharing with First Nations, and
- completion of timber supply analysis reports, including base case forecast, sensitivities and socio-economic assessment.

The activities that are not eligible include:

- activities related to funding for participation in public or First Nations reviews, such as travel costs, etc;
- any type of resource inventories, for example operability, site productivity, visual sensitive areas, recreation, etc;
- forest planning or timber supply analyses for purposes other than those required to support considerations under the Forest Act, Section 8(8);
- part or all activities that have already been completed to standard for a whole TSA, and funded for similar FIA activities such as IFPA analyses, for example in the Okanagan TSA;
- activities related to the incorporation of new organizational bodies, such as societies or associations;
- development and/or population of data outside of the timber supply review requirements;
- purchase of software/hardware, software maintenance fees;
- application and computer systems development.

Eligible Activities for 2004/2005:

- For fiscal 2004/05, the following activities in the noted management units will be eligible for FIA funding. However, some of these (where noted) may be subject to a postponement by the chief forester during this fiscal year.
