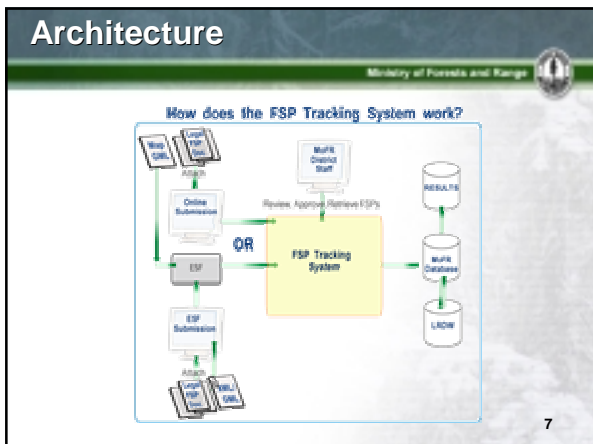

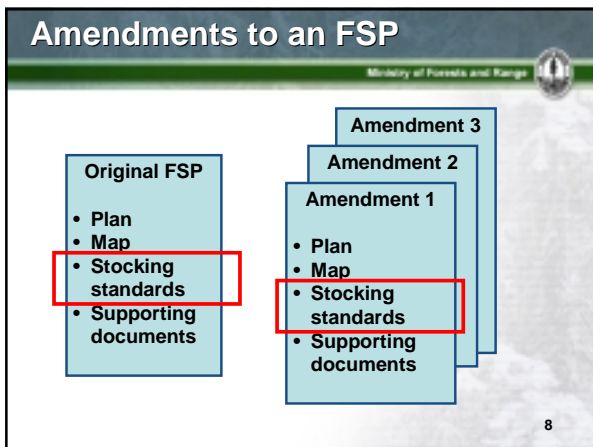
What does it do?

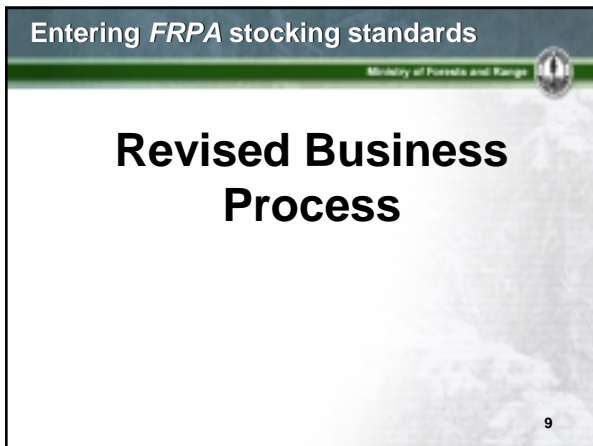

graph TD; A[Submit FSP and Amendments (Licensee)] --> B[Review FSP and Amendments (MoFR)]; B --> C[Approve/Reject FSP and Amendments (MoFR)]; C --> D[View FSPs and Amendments (All)];
```

Revised business process

Ministry of Forests and Range

- **Stocking Standards for Code blocks and woodlots**
 - maintain in RESULTS (no change)
 - cannot be used in FSP blocks
- **Stocking Standards for FRPA blocks**
 - Licensee/BCTS submit or enter into FSP Tracking System
 - **Stocking standard ID assigned**
 - Approved and passed to RESULTS when FSP approved

Implications

Ministry of Forests and Range

- **Enter FSP stocking standards into FSP Tracking System**
 - Must be entered before FSP is marked as approved
- **Minimal change management**
 - Data entry same in FSP Tracking System and RESULTS
 - Continue to use RESULTS functionality for silviculture reporting
- **Paper-based submissions**
 - Must be entered into the FSP Tracking System and FSP marked as approved before stocking standards are available in RESULTS

Option 1: E-Submission

```
graph LR; A[ESF (XML/GML)] --> B[Attach FSP legal Document and Stocking Standards Report (optional)]; A --> C[Submit stocking standards];
```

SS_ID automatically assigned by FSP Tracking System

Option 2: Online Submission

```
graph LR; A[FSP Tracking System] --> B[Attach FSP legal Document and Stocking Standards Report (optional)]; A --> C[Enter stocking standards]
```

SS_ID automatically assigned as entered into FSP Tracking System

Option 3: Paper Submission

```
graph LR; A[FSP (paper) submission] --> B[Submit FSP legal document as E-Submission (Option 1)]; A --> C[Enter stocking standards online (Option 2)]
```

 - FSP legal document on attachments tab
 - Stocking standards report on attachments tab
- QA process to confirm stocking standards in FSP Tracking System match FSP version

Summary—revised business process

Ministry of Forests and Range

- **FPC and Woodlot stocking standards**
 - Maintained in RESULTS
- **FRPA stocking standards**
 - Entered into FSP Tracking System
 - Not entered or approved in RESULTS
 - Complete entry before approving FSP
 - Automatically passed to RESULTS for use in openings (when approved)
