Forest Science Program researchers started working in 1990, in partnership with industry, to develop alternative silvicultural systems for timber harvesting which preserve caribou habitat. These innovative partial-cutting systems are being applied to a number of caribou winter ranges in the province. For example, under the Cariboo-Chilcotin Land-Use Plan, modified harvesting is being practised on 250,000 hectares across the Cariboo Forest Region.
