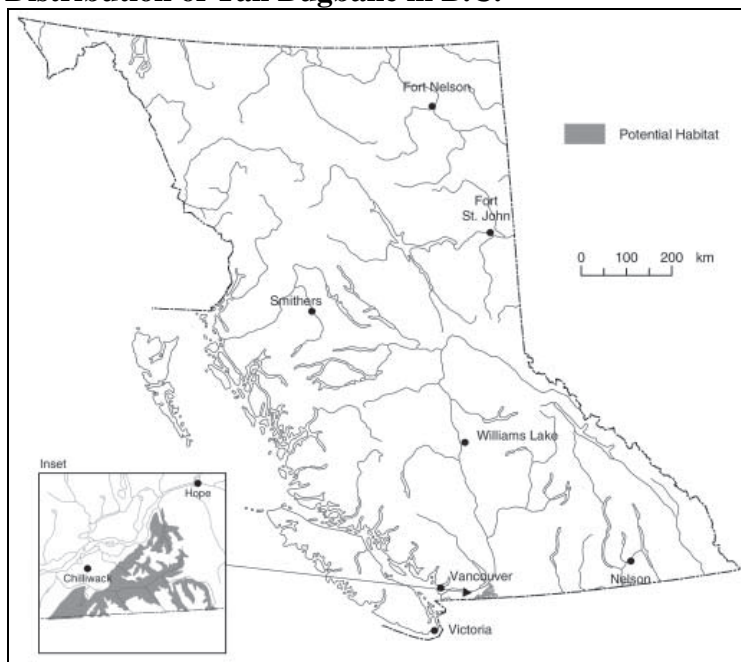


## Tall Bugbane in British Columbia

### Summary of population size and trend

Seven populations of Tall Bugbane, a rare vascular plant known to occur only in the Chilliwack River Valley, have been verified (Environment Canada 2004; Identified Wildlife 2004; see links below for references). Populations range from one to 63 plants and these small, sporadically distributed populations are vulnerable to low genetic diversity and extirpation. Absent from young 15-30 year old managed stands, the species is also threatened by forest fragmentation.

### Criteria for selection of Tall Bugbane for this indicator:

- A species designated as Identified Wildlife under the *Forest and Range Practices Act*; and
- A species at risk where timber management is a known major threat.
