Communications Plan:

Any concerns about livestock location or potential impacts to water quality will be addressed by contacting the following:

1. **Rancher:** Once contacted, rancher is to verify concern and remove livestock to a suitable location within a 24-hour period. Once livestock have been removed, a report of activity is to be communicated to the water purveyor and the Range Program (standardized form).
2. **Range Program:** Range program to verify concern and inspect for impact as per the monitoring plan. Log of reports kept for verification and reporting in the event of the need for follow-up. Monitoring reports will be provided to water purveyor and rancher. Any high risk inspections will be reported immediately for remediation actions.
3. **Water Purveyor:** Notify rancher and Range staff of any concerns about livestock location and/or water sample results. Location of water sampling to be identified prior to turnout of livestock.

Interior Health will be notified by the water purveyor as per water license agreement. Any changes to this plan will be communicated to Interior Health.
