

Question

What is required to be provided in the appraisal data submission to qualify for the Destumping Specified Operation?

Response

The section of the signed Site Plan which requires that destumping be done for root disease control on an area harvested in the cutting authority must be attached in ECAS.

The area that will have destumping must be delineated on the appraisal map and attached in ECAS.

How the cost per cubic metre, which is entered in the Specified Operation (ECAS34) screen, was developed must be either in the initial comments in ECAS or attached as a separate document. The following is an example of what is being sought for a Destumping Specified operation of \$0.13 per cubic metre.

Example

2.5 ha to be destumped in cutting authority

21,354 cubic metres in cutting authority

\$1,114 (cost per ha in January 15, 2009 CAM)

$$(2.5 \times 1,114) / 21,354 = \$0.13 \text{ per m}^3$$
