

Inocybe lanuginosa

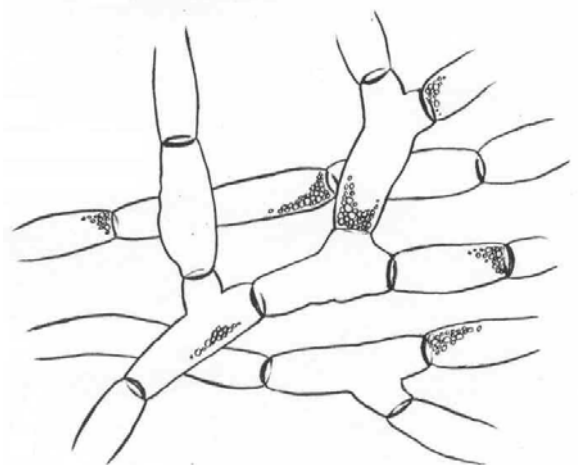
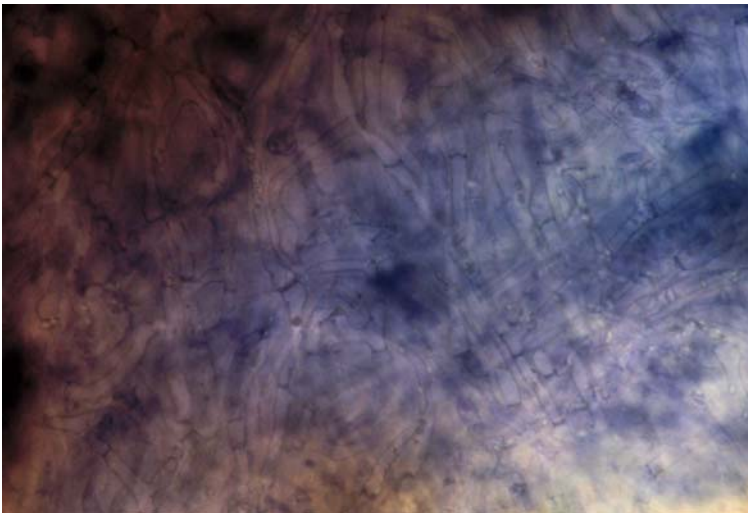
Tips

Monopodial pinnate root systems, with bent tips. Smooth texture, with a pinky-orange colour on older tips. Fairly large root tips, often pinched in between successive tips. No mycelial strands and no emanating hyphae.



Outer mantle

Net prosenchyma, cells 2 to 3 μm wide, with intermittent oil-like bodies. Septas very common, often quite dark, and the full elliptical shape is visible. Cells often pinched in at septa, the hyphae sometimes enlarged in spots and often running parallel to each other. No clamps, and hyphal junctions common.



Inner mantle

Often difficult to see, the inner mantle is a net prosenchyma, 2 to 3 μm wide. Septas common, with cells pinched in at septa. Hyphae often running parallel to each other. No clamps or ornamentation.
