

Lactarius scrobiculatus

Tips

Monopodial pinnate with bent tips, quite large in size. Young tips a pearly-white, almost frosted look, becoming more yellowy-green on older tips. Smooth texture mostly, but mantle on oldest tips a bit pitted like the sporocarp. Occasional restricted point mycelial strands found, not sure if connected.



Outer mantle

Net synenchyma, cells 5 μm wide (4 to 10 μm), with varying sizes of globular ornamentation. Oil-like bodies also common, but not continuous, sometimes appearing more like finger-prints (see second photograph and drawing). Few to rare septas, no clamps, and few hyphal junctions.
