

Lactarius uvidus

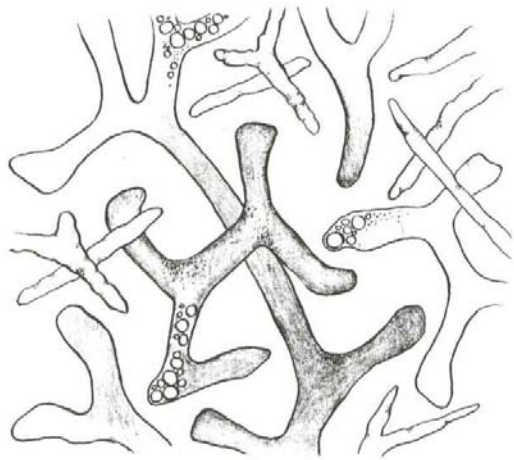
Tips

Monopodial pinnate root systems, with bent root tips. Golden brown in colour with pearl apices, becoming golden lavender brown with age. Smooth texture, with no mycelial strands nor emanating hyphae.



Outer and middle mantle

Outer felt prosenchyma, cells 2-3 μm wide, often forming a star-like pattern, with crystalline ornamentation and some granular contents. No clamps and no septas. A middle mantle is also present, with frequently branched cells, occasionally with oil bodies, and no ornamentation.



Inner layer

Interlocking irregular synenchyma, 4-6 μm wide and 15-25 μm long. Clear contents, no ornamentation, and no clamps.
