## FOREWORD

The 1984 Forest and Range Resource Analysis Report summarizes and comments upon timber, range and recreation statistics presented at the provincial and regional level of detail. Background information necessary for development of the report was provided by the Ministry of Forests' Regional offices and Victoria Branches. Statistics were prepared at the Regional and Timber Supply Area (TSA) level of detail.

The purpose of this Background Report is to provide data for the reader who desires more detail than that provided in the main report. To this end, it is primarily a presentation of detailed statistics, with a brief descriptive text.

The information presented in this report was specially prepared for the Resource Analysis and is not found in this form in any other ministry publication. The data is presented unedited and there may be some differences between tables, however, the differences are not significant in the context of planning the future of the resource.

The following presents a detailed description of the provincial timber, range and recreation resources over which the Ministry of Forests has the jurisdiction for management.
