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## Data Dictionary

This document provides basic details of the database fields found in the digital map deliverables. Further detailed information about the data structures can be found in the Resources Inventory Committee (RIC) Standard – *Digital Data Standards for a Community-Scale Tourism Opportunity Strategy*. This document concludes with a listing of the digital map files found on the accompanying CD.

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### **Map Compilation**

Maps and digital data layers used to complete this study were acquired through a variety of sources, detailed later in this document. All digital map files developed during this project meet. The following specifications were used to develop the map files:

### **Base Map Layers**

Two base maps were compiled for this project. The 1:20,000 basemap was derived from the 71 TRIM mapsheets. While the data source scales varied from 1:250,000 to 1:20,000, all features were matched against the 1:20,000 TRIM digital basemap. Data was presented at a 1:400,000 scale using the provincial 1:250,000 digital basemap. Because of licensing restrictions, TRIM data is not included in the accompanying CD.

### **Existing Use Layers**

A number of existing use layers were developed for this project. All databases and map files have been rigorously matched to the TRIM basemap and meet the RIC standards. A data dictionary describing the layers and database structures can be found later in this document. Although all existing use files contain the abbreviation **DSA** (indicating the geographic extent of the coverage is the Salmon Arm Forest District), all files also include portions of the Vernon Forest District that also fall within the study area.

### **Tourism Operator Listings (spreadsheet)**

The Ministry of Sustainable Resource Management provided a database of 77 tourism operators identified as operating in the Study Area in the 1995 Tourism Resource Inventory (TRI). The consultant team focused on verifying that operators were still in business, identifying new tourism operators and updating the database to meet the revised RIC standards.

To verify and update the database, the consultant team did an extensive review of secondary published sources and the internet (see below). All information in the tourism operator database is accurate as of Dec. 31, 2001.

Each operator has been assigned a unique six digit identifier call a *tourcode*. Tourism operators identified in the 1995 inventory have tourcodes beginning with 300. Operators compiled for the list for this project were arbitrarily assigned a tourcode, starting with 310. The last code assigned was 310259. A total of 316 tourism operators were identified for this project.

The spreadsheet contains four workbooks. The first (*MASTER\_LIST*) contains a complete listing of tourism operators (as defined in the RIC standards) based in or using the study area. Operators tentatively identified, but removed from the master list are found in the *SHUSWAP\_DEL* workbook, which includes a reason for their removal. *SHUSWAP PARKS* contains a limited listing of Provincial Parks in the study area which contain camping opportunities. *MISC (FROM RINO)* is the final workbook and contains miscellaneous, tourism related businesses identified by members of the advisory committee which do not fit RIC's strict definition of a tourism operator. Only the *MASTER\_LIST* workbook is described in the data dictionary below.

## Facilities

Most tourism operators have a facility or base of operations; some may also have satellite camps. These have been captured as a point in the facility coverage. Every effort has been made to ensure facilities are spatially located as accurately as possible. Facility locations have been matched to the TRIM basemap. Each facility contains a *tourcode* that can be used to link up to the tourism operator database. Tourcodes may not be unique to each facility point because one operator may have several facilities. Similar types of facilities (e.g. hotel or lodge) can be identified through the *fcode*.

## Features

Tourism features, consisting of sites, routes/trails, or areas important to tourism operators, are captured primarily as points, lines or polygons. Features can be broadly grouped into four categories.

- Geological/natural features (significant beaches, waterfalls, mountain peaks, and rock bluffs, areas frequented by wildlife).
- Water features (rivers, waterfalls and hot springs).
- Man-made features (campsites, sites of historic or cultural significance, boat launch, trail).
- Activity sites/routes/areas (wildlife viewing sites, hiking, fishing).

Provincial Park campgrounds and Forest Service Recreation sites are included as point features in this coverage. This coverage does not include heritage or archaeological sites unless they were explicitly identified as a tourism resource by a tourism operator or in one of the secondary sources. Features have been matched to the TRIM basemap.

The *activity* and *feature* fields contain information on the type of feature and/or activity each point, line or polygon represents. The *source* field indicates how the feature was identified (e.g. through tourism operator survey, secondary published source, field work). The *comments* field provides additional information, such as the feature name or a description of the feature. The features file should not be considered comprehensive, although it is believed that most important tourism features have been captured. No analysis has been undertaken to determine the appropriateness of the feature to support sustainable tourism. No ground-truthing has been undertaken to verify the positional accuracy of the feature datasets.

## Suitability Layers

Suitability maps illustrate existing or potential tourism opportunities taking into consideration a range of constraints. Suitability layers consist mainly of polygons, although some products are depicted as lines. Areas are classified as **low**, **medium** or **high** suitability for recreation. A data dictionary describing the layers and database structures can be found later in this document.
