

July 28, 2018 – 1600 hrs



Activity increased on the north flank of the Snowy Mountain Fire (K51238) earlier this afternoon. The fire moved into a grassy area, where helicopters were deployed to cool the fire. The fire activity has lessened but helicopters continue to work some areas. The fire has not reached the trigger points set out by land managers which would result in a reassessment of the fire.

The fire is very visible from Cawston but is not considered an interface fire at this time.
