**BC WILDFIRE SERVICE
AREA RESTRICTION ORDER
Testalinden Creek Wildfire – K50615**

Under section 11(1) of the *Wildfire Act*, and pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Minister of Natural Resource Operations, for public safety and in order to avoid interference with fire control, I, Murray Henry, Fire Centre Manager, hereby designate the area described below as a restricted area.

Under this Order and section 11(2) of the *Wildfire Act*, a person must not remain in or enter the restricted area without the prior written authorization of an official designated for the purposes of the *Wildfire Act*, unless the person

Enters the area only in the course of:

- (a) Travelling to or from his or her residence;
- (b) Using a highway as defined in the *Highway Act*, or
- (c) Travelling to or from cellular and other installations with permission from the Incident Commander or designate.

This Order takes effect immediately and remains in force until the earlier of 16:00 Pacific Daylight Time on Wednesday, September 30, 2015 or until the Order is rescinded.

This Order applies to Crown land within the geographic boundaries described below and as outlined and shaded in purple on the attached map:

North Boundary: From coordinate 49° 10.776 x 119° 40.452 directly northwest approximately 5.4 kilometres to the power-line right-of-way; coordinate 49° 12.233 x 119° 41.800. Following the power-line right-of-way northeast to coordinate 49° 13.700 x 119° 40.050, continue in a southeast direction along the power-line right-of-way to the intersection of the power-line right-of-way and the Oliver Fire Department Response Boundary.

East Boundary: From the intersection of the power-line right-of-way and the Oliver Fire Department Response Boundary, extending south along the Oliver Fire Department Response Boundary to coordinate 49° 04.588 x 119° 32.233.



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South Boundary: From coordinate 49° 04.588 x 119° 32.233 directly west to Highway 3, follow the boundary of Highway 3 until the junction of Highway 3 and the Kobau-Lookout FSR;

West Boundary: Following the Kobau-Lookout FSR to terminus; and following the height of the land from the Kobau-Lookout FSR terminus approximately 7.4 kilometres to coordinate 49° 10.776 x 119° 40.452.
