

## **2010 Administrative Decision Listing - Proposed Coast Forest Region**

### **Tree Farm Licence (TFL) Replacement**

Tree farm licences (TFL) grant the holder rights to a volume of timber within a TFL area and have a term of 25 years. An offer from the Minister of Forests and Range (the Minister) to replace the TFL with another TFL may be made during the 6 months beginning on any of the fourth to ninth anniversaries of the licence. The term of the replacement licence begins on the next anniversary following the offer of replacement. If the offer of replacement is declined, then the TFL will be in effect until the term expires.

### **Timber Supply Review and Allowable Annual Cut Determination**

Allowable Annual Cut (AAC) determinations are made periodically for TFL, Timber Supply Areas (TSA) and woodlot licences and set the amount of timber that may be harvested within the TFL or TSA.

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### **Timber Supply Area AAC Apportionment Decisions**

The AAC of a timber supply area may be apportioned by the minister under Section 10 of the *Forest Act*. Apportionment decisions for a TSA generally occur following a section 8 determination by the chief forester, a change in the land base available for harvesting or a change in the government objectives for the AAC. ### **Timber Sale Licence Conversion**

The *Forest (Revitalization) Amendment Act, 2003* amended the *Forest Act* such that all timber sale licences (TSL) entered into under section 24 of the former *Forest Act* must be converted to another licence. The holder of a timber sale licence elected another licence form as indicated in the following table. The regional manager or district manager may enter into the new licence this year. A replaceable TSL that had an AAC greater than 10,000 cubic meters automatically converted to a replaceable forest licence. Consultation and operational planning must still be carried out for operations under a new licence.

### Non Replaceable Forest Licence Advertisement

A non-replaceable forest licence (NRFL) grants the holder of the licence the right to apply for cutting permits to harvest timber within specified areas of the applicable Timber Supply Area or Tree Farm Licence. Applications via competitive bid would be advertised for these licences and will primarily utilize unused volume sources.

### Timber Licence Extension

Timber Licences (TL) grant the holder exclusive rights to harvest merchantable timber within a specific area of Crown land. Prior to the expiration of the term of a TL, the holder of a TL may apply to the regional manager to extend the term for a period not exceeding 3 years. The following TLs will be considered for extension within the next year. Consultation and operational planning must still be carried out for operations under an extended licence. In some instances, consultation is complete however a decision is still pending.

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### Community Forest Agreements (CFA)

A Community Forest Agreement (CFA) grants the holder exclusive timber harvesting rights within the CFA area and may also grant the holder rights to non-timber forest products as well. A new CFA can have a term ranging from 25 to 99 years. Current Ministry policy is for a 25 year term. Consultation will be undertaken prior to approval of the management plan and before issuance of the agreement. Probationary or Pilot CFA's may be converted to a CFA at the request of the tenure holder. In 2010/2011, it is anticipated that 4 of the existing PCFA's will be converted to a CFA. Each will require consultation for this conversion to be considered.

As a result of entering into an agreement (Forest and Range Agreement, or interim measures agreement for example), a First Nation may be invited to apply for timber harvesting rights for a volume of timber in the form of a tenure. The province is intending to offer and issue these tenures following the conclusion of First Nations consultation on these licence opportunities.
