TITLE: Growth of White Pine on the Queen Charlotte Islands

LOCATION: Dead Tree Point, Queen Charlotte Islands

BACKGROUND: White Pine (Pw) is a highly valued species with, of course, the problem of Blister Rust. It was felt that Pw may grow well on the Charlottes, and that Blister Rust may not be present.

OBJECTIVE: Assess the growth of Pw and test for the presence of White Pine Blister Rust on the Queen Charlotte Islands.

PROGRESS: -300 Pw planted in Spring 1988
