

CAMPFIRE REGULATIONS

- Campfires must NOT be larger than 0.5 metres high by 0.5 metres wide.
- You MUST have a shovel OR at least eight litres of water nearby to extinguish the fire.
- A firebreak must surround your fire. Create one by scraping down to the dirt one metre around the fire.
- NEVER leave a campfire unattended for any length of time.
- Before leaving the area, always ensure that your campfire is completely extinguished and the ashes are cool to the touch.



- Anyone violating a campfire or open burning regulation may be issued a violation ticket fine of \$1,150. If the violation causes a wildfire, the person responsible may also be ordered to pay all firefighting and associated costs.
