Logbook Rating Guide

Performance Rating:

S - Satisfactory

Minor or no errors, objectives achieved in an efficient professional manner, anticipates and adapts to change.

SB - Satisfactory with Briefing

Some minor errors made however did not affect attainment of objectives. Meets minimum requirements.

U - Unsatisfactory

Errors or omissions made which required considerable input from other personnel (or crews). Objectives achieved with difficulty or not met. Operations carried out in a non-professional manner.

NR - Not Rated

This performance indicator was not rated, usually because it was not related to the position being evaluated.

NT - Needs Training

This rating is usually used in the case where the person (or crew) being rated is not certified for the position which they were performing.

NE - Needs Experience

This could be used in the case where a person being rated is not certified or, where in the opinion of the supervisor, the person being rated is simply lacking in experience.
